- 2.2 The Director General, Sri Lanka Customs is hereby authorized to release any Cargo / Consignment of goods, classified under the HS Codes as referred in the Regulation No.2 above; and arrived at any Port / Airport of Sri Lanka during the period of April 16, 2020 to June..08., 2023 violating the Imports and Exports Regulations on Temporary Suspension of importation of such goods; for which, no Customs Declaration (Bill of Entry) / CUSDEC) has yet been submitted to the Sri Lanka Customs for the purpose of the provisions of the Government Revenue Protection (Special Provisions) Act, No. 01 of 2006; on the approval of Controller General of Imports and Exports Control, subject to payment of **Additional Fee of 15% of the CIF Value** of such consignment / cargo to the Controller General of Imports and Exports Control.
- 2.3 Importation of Construction / Project related goods, specified in the **Schedule I** of the Imports and Exports (Control) Regulations No. 02 of 2023, except vehicles, auto parts, plastic goods, and agricultural products, by the Project Company or Authorized Persons of the Colombo Port City Economic Commission Act, No. 11 of 2021 or sourced through contractors provided that the goods are consigned in the name of the Project Company or Authorized Persons for the purpose of the development activities within the area of authority of the Colombo Port City are allowed on the recommendation of the Colombo Port City Economic Commission on consignment basis including “No Foreign Exchange (NFE)” basis.
3. The Imports Control Regulations on Payment Terms No. 07 of 2022, published in the Gazette Extraordinary No. 2278/21 dated May 06, 2022, as amended, is hereby further amended.
- 3.1 Regulation Nos. 4(f) and 4(g) are hereby inserted immediately after the Regulation No. 4(e) of the Imports Control Regulations on Payment Terms No. 04 of 2023, published in the Gazette Extraordinary No. 2320/46 dated February 22, 2023, and read as follows:
